

ENTRANCE AGE REQUIREMENTS

A pupil may enter kindergarten if the child's chronological age will be five (5) before September 30 of the year entering school. *No waiver of this kindergarten entrance age provision shall be granted. Policy JEB-R shall not apply.*

A pupil may enter Grade 1 if the child's chronological age will be six (6) before September 30 of the year entering school.

A birth certificate must be presented upon registration as proof of the date of birth.

Incoming transfer students in Grades 2-6 inclusive will be initially placed in accordance with the date forwarded by the sending district. Such placement is tentative and subject to reassignment by the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee.

Incoming transfer students in Grade 1 will only be initially admitted to Grade 1 if their chronological age will be six (6) before September 30 of the year of entering school or if previously enrolled in Grade 1 in another community. Such placement is tentative and subject to reassignment by the Principal after developmental/academic evaluation.
