Student rights and responsibilities shall be published in the Parent-Student Handbook, and will be made available in another language or presented orally upon request.

Student rights and responsibilities shall be published in the Parent-Student Handbook, and will be made available in another language or presented orally upon request. Student disciplinary procedures will be implemented pursuant to the provisions of Board Policies JIC and Policy JICD.

Due process requires that an individual be given notice of the violation (s) for which that person is being charged and be given an opportunity to answer the charges.

In suspension or dismissal, due process must involve:

- a. Notification...why the suspension and the explanation for it
- b. Evidence...who, what, where, when, why:
- c. Hearing.....formal or informal depending on the length of the suspension.
