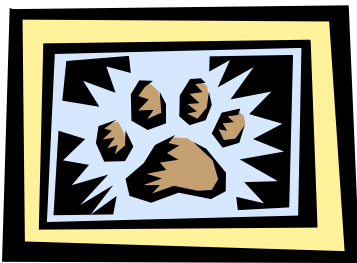


PBIS Mission Statement

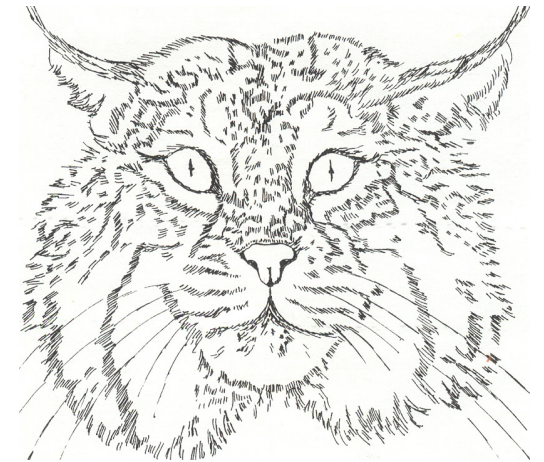

Hallway

Safe

- Keeps hands and feet to self
- Walk facing forward
- Walk 2 by 2
- Stay to the right

Respectful

- Respect others' space
- Enjoy artwork and displays with your eyes
- Use your manners
- Give a *quiet* wave or compliment

Responsible

- Go directly to your destination and return promptly
- Be aware that others are working

- Flush
- Wash

Classroom

Safe

- Follow adult directions
- Follow classroom rules
- Keep to your assigned areas

Respectful

- Listen and respect others' opinions
- Work quietly
- Take pride in your work
- Do your part

Responsible

- Be prepared
- Use your time wisely
- Make good use of tools and organizers
- Ask for help

Cafeteria

Safe

- Walk slowly and safely
- Choose a seat and stay in your spot while eating
- Stay seated with hands and feet to yourself

Respectful

- Have quiet conversations with the friends at your table
- Use your manners
- Look and listen to adults when signaled

Responsible

- Eat and be neat
- Do your share and clean with care
- Make sure trash goes in the can
- "Stash your trash"

Playground

Safe

- Follow game and equipment rules
- Stay in designated play areas
- Play safely

Respectful

- Give others their personal space
- Be a friend
- Listen to teachers

- Line up
