

Kindergarten and First Grade REGISTRATION

REGISTRATION FOR INCOMING KINDERGARTEN, READINESS AND 1ST GRADE STUDENTS IS NOW OPEN! PARENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO ENROLL KINDERGARTEN, READINESS AND 1ST GRADE STUDENTS FOR THE 2025-2026 SCHOOL YEAR USING OUR ONLINE REGISTRATION SYSTEM AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. WE ARE HOLDING AN INFORMATION SESSION FOR READINESS AND 1ST GRADE ON APRIL 10TH AT 6 PM, AND HOLDING SCREENINGS IN EARLY SPRING. PLEASE REGISTER YOUR CHILD TO ENSURE YOU RECEIVE LETTERS FROM US REGARDING THESE EVENTS. (IF YOUR CHILD ALREADY ATTENDS PRESCHOOL OR KINDERGARTEN AT NBCS YOU DO NOT NEED TO REGISTER)

DEPENDING ON THE YEAR WE CAN TYPICALLY HAVE BETWEEN TWO TO FOUR KINDERGARTEN SESSIONS AND THREE OR FOUR 1ST GRADE CLASSES AND THEREFORE NEED TO PLAN STAFFING NEEDS ACCORDINGLY. BY REGISTERING EARLY THIS HELPS US GET A HEAD COUNT FOR BUDGETING AND STAFFING PURPOSES.

YOUR CHILD MUST BE FIVE YEARS OLD BY SEPTEMBER 30TH 2025 TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR PUBLIC KINDERGARTEN AND 6 YEARS OLD BY SEPTEMBER 30TH 2025 TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR 1ST GRADE AND READINESS. TO HELP YOU PREPARE TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD YOU WILL BE ASKED FOR THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS DURING THE REGISTRATION

PROCESS

- A COPY OF YOUR CHILD'S BIRTH CERTIFICATE.
- A COPY OF YOUR CHILD'S IMMUNIZATION RECORD.
- A PHYSICAL EXAMINATION FOR YOUR CHILD BY A QUALIFIED PHYSICIAN WITHIN ONE YEAR PRIOR TO ENTERING SCHOOL.
- TWO PROOFS OF RESIDENCY -
- UTILITY BILL OR DEPOSIT RECEIPT INDICATING ADDRESS
- PURCHASE AND SALES AGREEMENT
- LEASE AGREEMENT
- VOTER REGISTRATION
- SOCIAL SERVICES PAPERS SOCIAL SECURITY, AFDC
- RENT RECEIPT INCLUDING VERIFICATION OF LANDLORD'S ADDRESS AND PHONE NUMBER
- WELFARE CARD

(IN THE UNUSUAL CASE THAT THESE ARE NOT AVAILABLE, A SIGNED AND NOTARIZED STATEMENT OF RESIDENCE MUST BE SUBMITTED.)

YOU WILL BE ABLE TO REGISTER YOUR STUDENTS USING THIS <u>LINK</u>. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU ARE REGISTERING FOR THE 2025-2026 SCHOOL YEAR.

PLEASE ENSURE YOU LEAVE PLENTY OF TIME AS THIS PROCESS CAN TAKE ANYWHERE BETWEEN 2-6 WEEKS BEFORE RESULTS ARE RECEIVED FROM THE STATE .
