# SCHOOL NURSE

FIRE PREVENTION WEEK: MONDAY OCTOBER 21ST THROUGH THURSDAY OCTOBER 24TH

AGAIN THIS YEAR, WE ARE FORTUNATE TO HAVE THE NEW BOSTON FIRE DEPARTMENT PROVIDE OUR ANNUAL FIRE SAFETY PROGRAM DURING THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 21ST. THIS EVENT IS FOR ALL GRADES, EXCEPT 6TH, WHO WILL HAVE A SEPARATE EVENT IN THE SPRING.

THE FIRE SAFETY TRAILER PROVIDES A REALISTIC SIMULATION OF FIRE SAFETY SCENARIOS IN A CONTROLLED ENVIRONMENT. THERE IS A SMOKE ALARM THAT SOUNDS LIKE A NORMAL HOUSE ALARM, AND A STROBE LIGHT DURING THE SCENARIO. THE "SMOKE" IS A WATER-BASED PRODUCT APPROVED FOR PEOPLE WEARING CONTACT LENSES AND PEOPLE WITH ASTHMA. THE ROOF HAS MULTIPLE VENTS SO THE AMOUNT OF "SMOKE" CAN BE CONTROLLED AT A LOW LEVEL.

### VISION & HEARING SCREENINGS

IF ANY PARENTS/GUARDIANS HAVE ANY QUESTIONS OR YOU DO NOT WANT YOUR CHILD(REN) TO PARTICIPATE IN VISION OR HEARING SCREENINGS DURING THE 24-25 SCHOOL YEAR, PLEASE OPT OUT BY CONTACTING THE SCHOOL NURSE, CHRISTEN DUDAS, BEFORE OCTOBER 18TH.

ON MONDAY OCTOBER 21ST AND WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 23RD WE WILL OFFER A FREE VISION SCREENING FOR YOUR CHILD(REN) IN PRESCHOOL, KINDERGARTEN, READINESS, 1ST, 3RD, AND 5TH GRADE AT NEW BOSTON CENTRAL SCHOOL. THE SCREENING INVOLVES A PEDIAVISION SPOT™ VISION SCREENER THAT AUTOMATICALLY DETECTS COMMON VISION PROBLEMS. MEMBERS OF THE LIONS CLUB WILL BE ASSISTING WITH THE SCREENING.

NO PHYSICAL CONTACT WITH YOUR CHILD IS NECESSARY, AND NO EYE DROPS WILL BE USED. THE SCREENING CONSISTS OF AN INSTANT SCAN (LIKE A PHOTOGRAPH) OF YOUR CHILD'S EYES. YOU WILL RECEIVE NOTIFICATION OF YOUR CHILD'S RESULTS AND IF FURTHER EVALUATION IS RECOMMENDED.

THE SCHOOL NURSE MAY ALSO SCREEN STUDENTS FOR HEARING DIFFICULTIES THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL YEAR. THIS SCREENING INVOLVES THE USE OF AN AUDIOMETER WHICH IS DESIGNED TO DETERMINE HEARING THRESHOLDS LEVELS. TESTING HEADPHONES WILL BE PLACED ON YOUR CHILD. A VARIETY OF TONES WITH VARIOUS LEVELS OF LOUDNESS WILL BE PRESENTED THROUGH THE HEADPHONES. YOUR CHILD WILL BE ASKED TO PRESS A BUTTON WHEN THEY HEAR THE TONE. YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED IF YOUR CHILD FAILS THEIR HEARING SCREENING AT SCHOOL.

AS WITH ANY TYPE OF VISION OR HEARING SCREENING, A "PASS" DOES NOT OVERRULE ANY ADDITIONAL CONCERNS REGARDING YOUR CHILD'S ABILITY TO SEE OR HEAR. A FULL AUDIOLOGIC OR VISION EVALUATION SHOULD BE DONE BY A SPECIALIST IF YOU HAVE CONCERNS ABOUT YOUR CHILD'S HEARING OR VISION.
