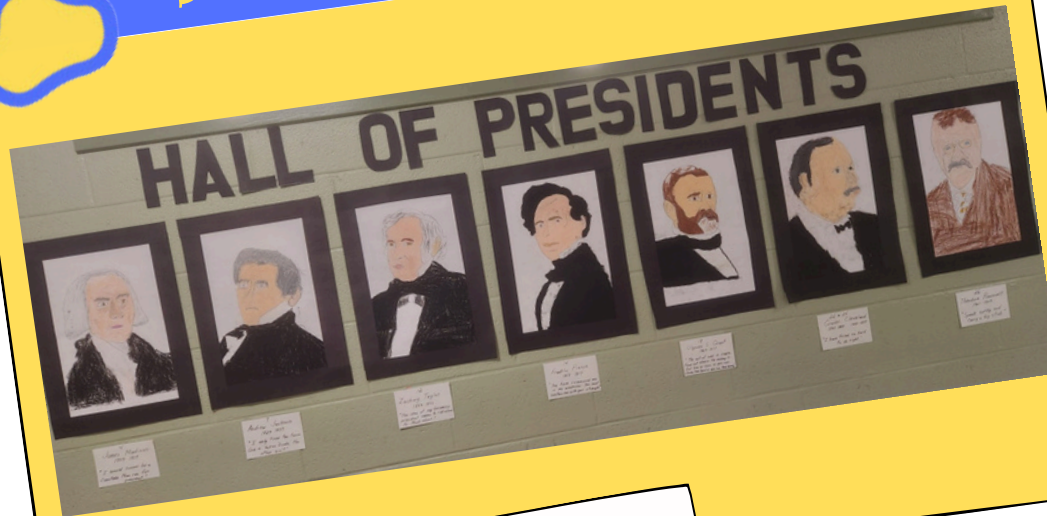

REGISTRATION FOR INCOMING KINDERGARTEN, READINESS AND 1ST GRADE STUDENTS IS NOW OPEN!

PARENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO ENROLL KINDERGARTEN, READINESS AND 1ST GRADE STUDENTS FOR THE 2025-2026 SCHOOL YEAR USING OUR ONLINE REGISTRATION SYSTEM AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.. WE WILL BE HOLDING INFORMATION SESSIONS AND SCREENING IN EARLY SPRING. PLEASE REGISTER YOUR CHILD TO ENSURE YOU RECEIVE LETTERS FROM US REGARDING THESE EVENTS. (IF YOUR CHILD ALREADY ATTENDS PRESCHOOL OR KINDERGARTEN AT NBCS YOU DO NOT NEED TO REGISTER)

DEPENDING ON THE YEAR WE CAN TYPICALLY HAVE BETWEEN TWO TO FOUR KINDERGARTEN SESSIONS AND THREE OR FOUR 1ST GRADE CLASSES AND THEREFORE NEED TO PLAN STAFFING NEEDS ACCORDINGLY. BY REGISTERING EARLY THIS HELPS US GET A HEAD COUNT FOR BUDGETING AND STAFFING PURPOSES.

YOUR CHILD MUST BE FIVE YEARS OLD BY SEPTEMBER 30TH 2025 TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR PUBLIC KINDERGARTEN AND 6 YEARS OLD BY SEPTEMBER 30TH 2025 TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR 1ST GRADE AND READINESS. TO HELP YOU PREPARE TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD YOU WILL BE ASKED FOR THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS DURING THE REGISTRATION PROCESS

- A COPY OF YOUR CHILD'S BIRTH CERTIFICATE.
- A COPY OF YOUR CHILD'S IMMUNIZATION RECORD.
- A PHYSICAL EXAMINATION FOR YOUR CHILD BY A QUALIFIED PHYSICIAN WITHIN ONE YEAR PRIOR TO ENTERING SCHOOL.
- TWO PROOFS OF RESIDENCY -
- UTILITY BILL OR DEPOSIT RECEIPT INDICATING ADDRESS
- PURCHASE AND SALES AGREEMENT
- LEASE AGREEMENT
- VOTER REGISTRATION
- SOCIAL SERVICES PAPERS - SOCIAL SECURITY, AFDC
- RENT RECEIPT INCLUDING VERIFICATION OF LANDLORD'S ADDRESS AND PHONE NUMBER
- WELFARE CARD



(IN THE UNUSUAL CASE THAT THESE ARE NOT AVAILABLE, A SIGNED AND NOTARIZED STATEMENT OF RESIDENCE MUST BE SUBMITTED.)

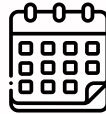

THIS DAY WOULD NOT HAVE BEEN A SUCCESS WITHOUT OUR PTA VOLUNTEERS AND PERSONNEL FROM PARKS AND RECREATION OFFERING THEIR TIME AND PROVIDING TRANSPORTATION. THANK YOU EVERYONE!!!!

ILLNESS:

IF YOUR CHILD EXHIBITS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS (TEMPERATURE GREATER THAN 100, DIARRHEA, VOMITING), PER OUR SCHOOL GUIDELINES, THEY MUST STAY HOME FROM SCHOOL.

WE ARE STILL SEEING VARIOUS ILLNESSES THROUGHOUT THE BUILDING. TO PREVENT THESE ILLNESSES FROM SPREADING, WE RECOMMEND THAT YOUR CHILD STAY HOME FROM SCHOOL IF EXPERIENCING FLU, COLD, OR GI SYMPTOMS. YOUR CHILD SHOULD BE PHYSICALLY ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL SCHOOL ACTIVITIES.

TO DECIDE WHETHER OR NOT TO SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL, PLEASE CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES: KEEP YOUR CHILD HOME FOR TREATMENT AND OBSERVATION IF EXPERIENCING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS:

TEMPERATURE GREATER THAN 100°F. YOUR CHILD SHOULD STAY HOME UNTIL AT LEAST 24 HOURS AFTER THEY NO LONGER HAVE A FEVER. THIS SHOULD BE DETERMINED WITHOUT THE USE OF FEVER-REDUCING MEDICINES (ANY MEDICINE THAT CONTAINS IBUPROFEN OR ACETAMINOPHEN).

FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE (CONTINUED)

VOMITING - HOME AT LEAST 24HRS AFTER NO LONGER VOMITING
DIARRHEA - HOME AT LEAST 24HRS AFTER NO LONGER HAVING DIARRHEA
CHILLS

GENERAL MALAISE OR FEELINGS OF FATIGUE, DISCOMFORT, WEAKNESS OR MUSCLE ACHES
FREQUENT COUGH

NASAL CONGESTION/RUNNY NOSE WITH FREQUENT NOSE BLOWING

IF SYMPTOMS ARE NOT IMPROVING, PLEASE CONTACT YOUR CHILD'S PCP FOR FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS.

IF YOU ARE UNSURE WHETHER YOUR CHILD SHOULD ATTEND SCHOOL, THE SCHOOL NURSE IS ALWAYS AVAILABLE AND WELCOMES QUESTIONS TO HELP YOU DECIDE IF YOUR CHILD IS ABLE TO ATTEND SCHOOL.

WE APPRECIATE YOUR HELP IN KEEPING OUR SCHOOL COMMUNITY HEALTHY!

REQUEST FOR CLOTHES:

IN THE FIRST INSTANCE, THE NURSE RECOMMENDS STUDENTS KEEP A CHANGE OF SEASONAL APPROPRIATE CLOTHES(T-SHIRT, PANTS, UNDERWEAR, SOCKS) IN INCIDENCES OF ACCIDENTS AND SPILLS, IN THEIR BACKPACKS. UNFORTUNATELY, STUDENTS DON'T ALWAYS LIKE THE "STYLE" OF CLOTHING AVAILABLE.

IN ADDITION, THE SCHOOL NURSE IS LOOKING FOR THE FOLLOWING CLOTHING DONATIONS. CLOTHES SHOULD BE GENTLY USED AND CLEANED:

IF YOUR CHILD WILL REQUIRE ANY DAILY MEDICATION

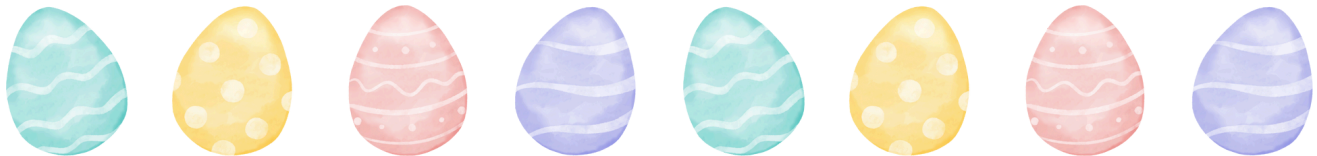
