- PLEASE ENROLL YOUR KINDERGARTEN, READINESS AND 1ST GRADE STUDENTS FOR THE 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR USING OUR ONLINE REGISTRATION SYSTEM. WE WILL BE HOLDING SCREENINGS IN THE NEXT 2-3 WEEKS. PLEASE REGISTER YOUR CHILD TO ENSURE YOU RECEIVE LETTERS FROM US REGARDING THESE EVENTS. (IF YOUR CHILD ALREADY ATTENDS PRESCHOOL OR KINDERGARTEN AT NBCS YOU DO NOT NEED TO REGISTER)
- DEPENDING ON THE YEAR WE CAN TYPICALLY HAVE BETWEEN TWO TO FOUR KINDERGARTEN SESSIONS AND THREE OR FOUR 1ST GRADE CLASSES AND THEREFORE NEED TO PLAN STAFFING NEEDS ACCORDINGLY.
- YOUR CHILD MUST BE FIVE YEARS OLD BY SEPTEMBER 30TH 2024 TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR PUBLIC KINDERGARTEN AND 6 YEARS OLD BY SEPTEMBER 30TH 2024 TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR 1ST GRADE AND READINESS.
