## DROP OFF AND PICK UP INFORMATION

At drop off and pick up our focus is having on having an efficient, timely process that is safe for our students and staff. Please refer to this [traffic pattern document](#) for parent drop off and pick up guidelines.

**PLEASE HAVE A LETTER SIZE SIGN WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME AND GRADE PLACED ON YOUR DASHBOARD SO WE CAN UNLOAD AND LOAD YOUR CHILDREN MORE QUICKLY**

This is especially important for Preschool and Kindergarten students. Please ensure your sign is placed on your dashboard and make eye contact with the traffic duty person as they will try and direct your car towards the sidewalk so staff can unload your child.

- For children who are exiting cars farthest from the sidewalk please have them walk between the rows of cars to the nearest crosswalk where traffic monitors are standing.
- Traffic guards will be signaling to you when it is safe to move your car.
- Students are organized in alphabetical order for pick up.

Morning drop off is between 7:45-8:00 am. School begins promptly at 8:00 AM each morning. Teachers take attendance at or shortly after 8:00 am. If your child arrives at the main entrance at 8:00 am or after, please have him/her stop in the office for a tardy slip. This process is necessary so that we clearly know which children are present or absent each day and so we do not alarm you when we call to verify your child's absence.

## BUS

Bus schedules can be found on the New Boston Central School website [here](#) Please be aware that the buses may run a couple of minutes late as our students get used to boarding their buses and the bus drivers get used to their routes.

Please remember that there will be no bus change notes.

**Children can only ride their regular bus to their place of residence or regular daycare.  
All children in 2nd grade and under will need to be met by a parent / guardian off the bus.**



## SAFESTOP BUS UPDATES

1. Download the SafeStop app from the App Store or Google Play.
2. Enter the NBCS school access code 403007
3. Enter your child's unique Student ID
4. Select the (bus or route name based on school communications preference) you wish to track.
5. Create alert zones around drop-off and pick-up points. You're all set! You will be able to track the bus's movement during active route times and receive notifications when the bus enters your custom alert zone(s).

## SNACKS AND LUNCH

Please be sure to send your child with a healthy snack if you have not ordered breakfast online. Each class has a designated snack break during the day in addition to their lunch break. If you do not have money on your child's lunch account you are welcome to send a check to the office made payable to NBCS- Food Services or make a payment online here. Please write your child's name and lunch ID on the envelope.

## ANNUAL BACK TO SCHOOL FORMS

### Emergency Contact Form

If you have not already done so please check and sign the emergency contact form sent home with your child on the first day of school and return it to school.

### Annual Back to School Forms

We are asking ALL families to complete our annual back to school student forms online. This process helps to reduce the amount of paper forms that go home and provides quicker delivery of information to our staff for processing and updating your student's information.

The information asked for in these forms is important as it pertains to any health conditions, medications your child may need to receive at school if anything happens.

To access these forms, log into the PowerSchool Portal at [sms.sau19.org](https://sms.sau19.org). Navigate to "Forms" in the left menu. We ask that one parent or guardian per student complete the required "Annual" forms listed as "Empty" to provide our schools with important student and health information, as well as provide the necessary acknowledgements and permissions for the new school year. Your completed forms will have the status of "Pending", "Submitted" or "Approved" as staff review and process forms over the upcoming weeks. If possible, please try to upload PDF files instead of phone screen shots due to upload and storage restrictions. ## OFFICE INFORMATION

### Absences

Please take the time to contact the school if your child will be absent.

You can email attendance to the office anytime at [nbc\\_s\\_attendance@sau19.org](mailto:nbc_s_attendance@sau19.org) or by calling anytime on our main number, 487-2211, and go into "general mailbox". Please report absences to the school prior to 8.30am.

If the school is not contacted the absence will be recorded as unexcused. Please read the attached policy with what counts as an excused absence. If there are a total of 10 1/2 day (5 full day) absences in a year this counts as truancy. Excused and unexcused absences will be reported to the State this school year.

### DESIGNATED VOLUNTEER / FINGERPRINTING FOR FIELD TRIPS

During the school year there may be opportunities for volunteering at the school. Any parent that is interested in volunteering to chaperone on their child's field trip if the opportunity arises will need to be background checked and fingerprinted. Please refer to our website to view procedures.

The Goffstown Police Department (GPD) has partnered with SAU 19 to provide a community service to support our school volunteers. GPD will now accept SAU 19 volunteers at the police station (located at 326 Mast Road) during the hours of 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM, Monday through Friday. Please note you only have 30 days from the date you get fingerprinted to get all the forms to the state, so it is critical you return the forms to the SAU ASAP after the fingerprinting.

**\*\*Please ensure you leave plenty of time as this process can take anywhere between 2-6 weeks.\*\***

## **NEW BOSTON RECREATION**
